## The Queen Elizabeth Parks Project - Park to Park Challenge Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> May 2020



**The Park to Park Challenge 2020** is an 8.5 mile walk along the Staunton Way and has been specifically chosen to be as accessible to as many people as possible.

Its purpose is to raise funds for the Queen Elizabeth Parks Project which supports wildlife conservation and education projects in Uganda's Queen Elizabeth National Park. We also get involved in wildlife conservation and

education activities in local schools here in England.

The Challenge starts in the main car park of Staunton Country Park at 9.30am and finishes at the Queen Elizabeth Country Park (we expect everyone to be finished by about 2.30pm)

This year we are giving participants the choice of either collecting sponsorship in the traditional way (using the form below) or as a simpler alternative, participants can encourage any potential sponsor to donate using the button on our website

All participants should wear appropriate clothing and footwear. It is advisable to make sure that you take water, snacks and a mobile phone with you on the walk.

The Park to Park Challenge organisers will be marshalling at all key road crossing points and marshals will be accompanying the walk at all times. There will also be a vehicle on standby in the unlikely event that anyone is injured on the walk.

Any sponsorship money collected can be paid directly to the Project via the donate button on our website or dropped into one of our Twinned Schools (cheques should be made payable to **Queen Elizabeth Parks Project**)

One of our main objectives this year is to raise funds to support wildlife education activities in Uganda.
